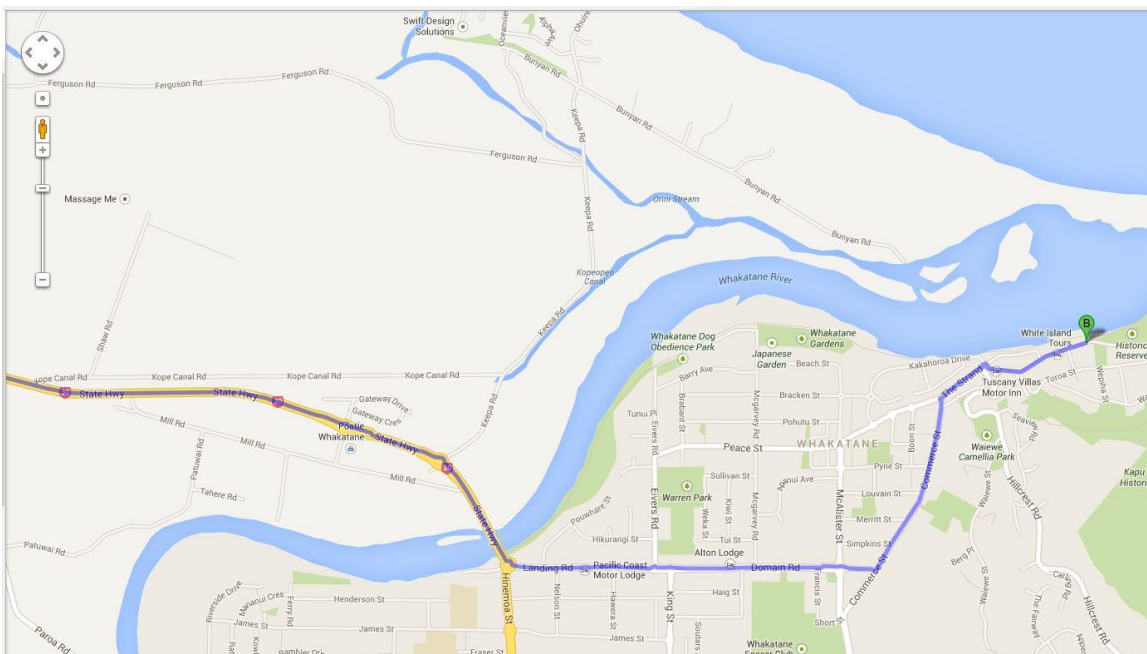
Cancellation and Refunds

Venue

Te Manuka Tūtahi Marae is located at 105 Muriwai Drive in Whakatāne, at the harbour entrance. For commuters travelling from outside of the Bay of Plenty, follow the SH2 or SH30 road signs to Whakatāne township and head to the town centre on The Strand. Follow this road which will lead into Muriwai Drive, as you head towards the Whakatāne Harbour.

The Whakatāne airport has connecting flights to and from Auckland. Alternatively, the Rotorua and Tauranga airports have frequent and regular flights to most main centres.



Pōwhiri

A pōwhiri / welcome will take place at 8.30am on Monday 02 December 2013, at Te Mānuka Tūtahi Marae with the assistance of the local iwi Ngāti Awa. The Mataatua rohe follow the pāke tikanga, whereby the tangata whenua speaks first, then the manuhiri follow.
